Advances in multiple disciplines including engineering, computer science, and cell biology now allow ultra-precise delivery of radiation (known as stereotactic radiotherapy) for cancer treatment. Stereotactic radiotherapy is now used for many cancers including those of the brain, lung, liver, and prostate. Recent advances also suggest an important role for stereotactic radiotherapy in the treatment of metastatic cancer.
