Gynecological cancer is an uncontrolled growth of abnormal cells that originate from women's reproductive organs. More than 90,000 women are diagnosed with gynecological cancer each year in the States. Join us virtually to learn about gynecologic malignancies including cervical, uterine, ovarian, vulvar, and vaginal cancer. Presenting symptoms, risk factors, screening, and treatment will be reviewed.

Dr. Gomez brings a unique perspective to her work as a City of Hope radiation oncologist. Dr. Gomez earned her medical degree at UCLA and continued her training there, rising to chief resident in the Department of Radiation Oncology. She is well-versed in many forms of radiation therapy including image-guided / intensity-modulated radiation therapy, stereotactic radiosurgery, and stereotactic body radiation therapy.
