We will discuss what high dose rate brachytherapy is and why we use it. We will also consider the evidence for use of HDR brachytherapy for favorable risk disease, the evidence for use for HDR brachytherapy for high-risk disease and HDR brachytherapy for radiorecurrent disease. Current research with HDR brachytherapy will also be discussed.

Dr. Albert Chang, Associate Professor, is the Vice Chair of Surgical Services and Brachytherapy Service Chief for the Department of Radiation Oncology at the David Geffen School of Medicine at UCLA and the UCLA Jonsson Comprehensive Cancer Center.
